Amazon Firestick QuickStart Guide

Activating Your Equipment

Step 1 – Connect HDMI Cable From Your Device to Your TV

The HDMI Adaptor is pictured below. Connect one end to your Firestick, and the other to your TV. The Firestick should hang from the TV outlet as pictured.



Step 2 – Connect Your Device to Power

Make sure your Firestick is connected to the device to an electrical outlet.



Step 3 – Turn on your TV and select the correct input

Use your TV remote to power on the TV, then press Input or Source (symbol looks like this: ) and choose the HDMI port your device is connected to. Menu labels may differ by TV brand. You should see your device's home screen.

Get Into BroadStream


Step 1 – Pair your remote

- ★ Amazon Firestick: Hold Home for 10 seconds until the light blinks, then follow on-screen prompts.




Step 2 – Connect to the internet

- ★ Use your Firestick remote (not your TV remote).
- ★ Navigate to the User icon all the way on the right.
- ★ Open your Network settings.
- ★ Select your WiFi network, and enter your password.



Step 3 – Download BroadStreamTV

- ★ Navigate to the magnifying glass button (search icon).
- ★ Navigate down and select "Appstore".
- ★ Search BroadStreamTV in the search bar. Highlight the BroadStreamTV app, select Install, and Open when complete.



Step 4 – Register your device

- ★ Enter your Subscriber Name, Password, and choose a Device Name. **(NOTE: Each device name must be unique.)**
- ★ Select Register to complete setup.



Step 5 – Start watching!

- ★ Press the right navigation button to pull up the menu. Explore the Guide, Search, and DVR menus to find what's on. **NOTE: the guide may take slightly longer to load if the app has just turned on or been restarted.**
